## **Keller Internet Training Center - HAZWOPER**

## This course meets the requirements in OSHA 29 CFR 1910.120 as an eight hour refresher course.



This course meets the requirements in OSHA 29 CFR 1910.120 for eight hours of annual refresher training for workers at hazardous waste sites who have already completed the 40-hour or 24-hour Hazardous Waste Operation and Emergency Response (HAZWOPER) training.

Through a series of online reading, writing, and interactive assignments, students review the HAZWOPER regulations, safety and health plans, hazardous chemicals, safety hazards, air monitoring, medical surveillance, site control, decontamination, personal protective equipment, and respiratory equipment.

## Participants will learn about the following topics:

- Understand and describe HAZWOPER's purpose and scope, as well as training requirements.
- Identify methods and procedures for recognizing, evaluating, and controlling hazardous substances and site hazards.
- Recognize chemical identification symbols and definitions.
- Describe the appropriate use of air and medical monitoring methods.
- Demonstrate the use, and understand the limitations, of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), including respiratory protection equipment.
- List emergency response procedures and spill prevention measures.
